

GOD'S DESIGN IN MAN'S CREATION: Adam in the Garden



Genesis 1:26-27 And God said, Let us make (asah) man in our image, after our likeness ... So God created (bara) man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

<u>Genesis 2:7</u> And the LORD God formed (*yatsar*) man *of* the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life (lit., "lives", Hbr., *chayim*); and man became a living soul (*nephesh*).

Summary of God's Original-Created-Man

- 1. God created man body, soul, and spirit
 - Soul: relates man to life and life forms
 - Spirit: designed by God to relate man to God
 - Body: designed by God to house soul-spirit in planet earth's environment.
- 2. That body, soul, and spirit are distinct entities in the believer is clear from 1Thess. 5:23.
- 3. It is in soul and spirit that man is in the image of God.
- 4. Soul and spirit are like two banks of the mind.
- 5. Soul-spirit is the real you: THE INVISIBLE YOU!
- 6. At physical death, the soul-spirit of a believer goes to be with the Lord, Phil. 1:21-24; James 2:26.
