Names or Terms	<p>“ _____ ”</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 3 times in the N.T., Rom. 6:6; Col. 3:9; Eph. 4:22 - a suitcase term that includes all the affects of the Fall upon the believer; involved is all that we are in Adam. - <u>KEY PASSAGE:</u> Rom. 6:6, our old man is positionally crucified in Christ (the verb is <u>aorist</u>, signifying the once-for-all fact of the matter, and <u>passive</u>, signifying that the believer does not do this himself, God did it, and <u>indicative in mode</u>, reaffirming the reality of the action). With Paul, every Believer can say, “<u>I am crucified with Christ...</u>” Gal. 2:20. God has taken care of the OLD MAN! 	<p>“ _____ ”</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Col. 3:10; Eph. 4:24 - “new” in quality and in time as opposed to the “old” worn-out Adamic man - synonymous with: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) “ _____ ,” Eph. 3:16; Rom. 7:22; 2Cor. 4:16; inner (unseen) as opposed to the “outer” (seen) 2) “ _____ in C.J.,” 2Cor. 5:17; “new” as opposed to “old” 3) “ _____ of the heart,” I Pet. 3:4, “unseen” person identified with Divine viewpoint frame of ref. as opposed to seen person with human viewpoint.
